

# G-141: Instructional Presentation and Evaluation Skills

**Course Description:** This 3-day course addresses the practicalities of conducting successful interactions, managing the classroom experience, and making presentations. It covers the basics of adult learning and of training evaluation for those wanting more experience in this area. Participants have several opportunities to practice presentation and instructional skills, first as spokespersons for small groups, then during short duo presentations, 3-minute individual presentations, and, finally, 20-minute individual presentations, using material related to their own programs or functions and detailed feed-

**Recommended Participants:** Anyone who wishes to become certified as a State of Ohio EMA Instructor or wants to sharpen their instruction skills
